Board Oath

Newly-elected board members, Ms. Donnay, Mr. Doshi, Mr. Hladick and Dr. Yu, all of whom had signed and executed the state required oath for school board members, were sworn into the board by Mr. Venanzi.

Mr. Venanzi welcomed all to the organization meeting.

Election of Officers

Acting as temporary chairperson, Mr. Venanzi opened nominations for president of the board of education.

Ms. Humza nominated Mr. Rimal for President. A motion was made by Dr. Yu and seconded by Mr. Hladick to close nominations for president and that one vote be cast for Mr. Rimal as president.

Upon call of the roll, the motion carried with eight members voting in favor and Ms. Donnay voting against.

Mr. Venanzi turned the meeting over to the newly-elected president.

President Rimal announced that nominations were open for vice president of the board of education.

Ms. Michaelson nominated Ms. Kirk-Csontos for vice president of the board of education. A motion was made by Mr. Hladick and seconded by Ms. Humza to close nominations for vice president and that one vote be cast for Ms. Kirk-Csontos as vice president.

Upon call of the roll, the motion carried with eight members voting in favor and Ms. Donnay voting against.

A motion was made by Mr. Goldoni and seconded by Ms. Kirk-Csontos that the Board of Education adopt the following resolution:

<u>Appointment of Board Secretary</u> - approve the appointment of Thomas M. Venanzi as Board Secretary and that the Board Secretary is authorized to invest district funds and make all deposits for the district.

Upon call of the roll, the motion carried with a unanimous vote recorded.

A motion was made by Ms. Kirk-Csontos and seconded by Ms. Humza that the Board of Education adopt the following resolutions:

<u>Official Newspapers for Publication of Legal Notices</u> - approve the designation of the The Courier News and/or The Star-Ledger as the newspapers to publish legal notices for the Board of Education.

<u>Official Newspapers for Publication of "Open Public Meeting Law" Notices</u> - approve the designation of The Princeton Packet, The Star-Ledger, The Courier News and The Trenton Times as the newspapers to receive notices of Board of Education meetings under the "Open Public Meetings Law."

Upon call of the roll, the motion carried with a unanimous vote recorded.

A motion was made by Mr. Goldoni and seconded by Dr. Yu that the Board of Education adopt the following resolutions:

TD Bank and Sovereign Bank Designated as Bank Depository - adopt the following resolution:

A motion was made by Mr. Hladick and seconded by Dr. Yu that the Board of Education adopt the following resolution:

<u>Regular Board Public Meetings</u> - adopt the attached calendar of Board of Education Meetings. Workshop Meetings will generally be held the second Tuesday of the month beginning at 7:30 p.m. The Business Meeting will generally be held the fourth Tuesday of the month beginning at 7:30 p.m. The meetings will be held in the Media Center of Montgomery Upper Middle School. During July, August and December one Board meeting a month is scheduled (see Page 7).

Upon call of the roll, the motion carried with a unanimous vote recorded.

A motion was made by Ms. Humza and seconded by Mr. Goldoni that the Board of Education adopt the following resolutions:

Existing Board Policies Adopted for Ensuing Year - adopt the existing policies of the Board of Education for the ensuing year with the understanding that revision of Board policy can be made at any time by Board action.

<u>Code of Ethics</u> - adopt the New Jersey School Boards Association (NJSBA) Code of Ethics as it appears in the district's policy manual (Bylaws 0142):

NJSBA Code of Ethics for School Board Members

- A. I will uphold and enforce all laws, state board rules and regulations, and court orders pertaining to schools. Desired changes should be brought about only through legal and ethical procedures.
- B. I will make decisions in terms of the educational welfare of children and will strive for public schools which can meet the individual needs of all children regardless of their ability, race, creed, sex or social standing.
- C. I will confine my board action to policymaking, planning, and appraisal, and I will help to frame policies and plans only after the board has consulted those who will be affected by them.
- D. I will carry out my responsibility, not to administer the schools, but together with my fellow board members, to see that they are well run.
- E. I will recognize that authority rests with the board of education and will make no personal promises nor take any private action, which may compromise the board.
- F. I will refuse to surrender my independent judgment to special interest or partisan political groups or to use the schools for personal gain or for the gain of friends.
- G. I will hold confidential all matters pertaining to the schools, which if disclosed, would needlessly injure individuals or the schools. But in all other matters, I will provide accurate information and, in concert with my fellow board member, interpret to the staff the aspirations of the community for its schools.
- H. I will vote to appoint the most qualified personnel available after consideration of the recommendation of the chief administrative officer.
- I. I will support and protect school personnel in proper performance of their duties.
- J. I will refer all complaints to the chief administrative officer and will act on such complaints at public meetings only after failure of an administrative solution.

Upon call of the roll, the motion carried with a unanimous vote recorded.

Mr. Rimal stated that he would announce committee assignments at the January 14, 2014 workshop meeting.

A motion was made by Ms. Kirk-Csontos and seconded by Mr. Goldoni that the Board of Education adopt the following resolution:

<u>Election of Delegate</u> - elect Ms. Humza as delegate to the Somerset County Educational Services Commission and Ms. Michaelson as alternate delegate.

Upon call of the roll, the motion carried with a unanimous vote recorded.

ANNOUNCEMENTS BY THE PRESIDENT

President Rimal congratulated the new board members and stated that our attorney will be present at the next board meeting to provide ethics training.

President Rimal and the board welcomed the alternate student representative, William Smith.

ADJOURNMENT

A motion was made by Mr. Goldoni and seconded by Ms. Kirk-Csontos to adjourn the meeting at 7:50 p.m. Upon call of the question, the motion carried unanimously.
