OPENING OF THE MEETING

- A. The Montgomery Township Board of Education held a workshop and business meeting on Tuesday, May 8, 2017 at 5:45 p.m. in the Upper Middle School media center.
- B. Roll Call - The following Board Members were present: Phyllis Bursh, Richard Cavalli, Minkyo Chenette, Dharmesh Doshi (arrived at 6:38 p.m.), Charles F. Jacey, Jr., Dr. Paul Johnson, Amy Miller (arrived at 5:59 p.m.), Ranjana Rao and Shreesh Tiwari (arrived at 5:59 p.m.)

- C. President Cavalli read the following Statement of Open Meeting and Public Participation - In accordance with the State's Sunshine Law, adequate notice of this meeting was provided by mailing notice of the meeting on January 10, 2018 and May 3, 2018. Notice was provided to Board of Education Members, Montgomery Township Clerk, Rocky Hill Borough Clerk, Public Library, Township Posting, School Postings, PTSA Officers, Courier News, Princeton Packet, Trenton Times, and The Star Ledger.
- D. President Cavalli then led everyone in the Salute to the Flag. Mr. Cavalli reiterated Ms. Gartenberg's comments from the April 26th BOE meeting regarding the flag at MHS. At that meeting, Ms. Gartenberg let the board know that she had investigated and sent out a message in response to previous public comment about the flag at MHS that was taken down. This was due to a problem with the flag pole that has been corrected and the flag has been restored.
- E. President Cavalli welcomed all to the workshop and business meeting.







Early Intervention Reduces Impact of Mental Health Conditions

- 1/2 of all lifetime cases of mental health conditions begin by age 14; 3/4 by age 24
- On average, > 6 years from onset of symptoms of M/SUDs to treatment
- Effective multi-sectoral interventions & treatments exist
- Need treatment & support earlier
 - Mental Health Screening
 - Brief Interventions
 - Coordinated referrals

Mental Health As Social Problem

- Public dialogue about mental health is in a social problem context rather than a public health context
- Public (and public officials) often misunderstand, blame, discriminate, make moral judgments, exclude
 - Ambivalence about worth of individuals affected and about the investment in prevention/treatment/recovery
 - Ambivalence about ability to impact "problems" and seeing immediate results




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


Problem

Solution
 Assess the mental health needs of the students • Obtain more information (from students) • Disseminate the information to appropriate audiences (through communication and education) • Translate the information into action (through programs, policies, and systems).

Ask
 Prevention dollars are limited and we want to make sure we are prioritizing concerns appropriately!
 We need help in identifying social norms of behaviors in order to correct misinformation and get ahead of the rumor mill. (Think UPSTREAM)

COMMITTEE/REPRESENTATIVE REPORTS

Student Representative Report

Ms. Gartenberg read a report from Ms. Nora Wynn, Student Representative, noting the following at MHS:

- AP testing has started this week
- Senior Prom is next Friday
- MHS students will be involved in a MHS UNICEF Clubs Color Run on May 20th
- Academic Awards ceremony will be on May 30th
- The Every Fifteen Minutes program put together a powerful, two-day presentation on the dangers of impaired or distracted driving, including a mock event which was a powerful reminder to students and parents

MTEA Report

Mr. Scott Mason, MTEA president, thanked the PTSA for the staff luncheons that were held last week. He reminded the board of the *Music from the Heart's* production of "Annie" that will be presented on May 12th. He encouraged all to attend as the event supports scholarships for MHS students. Ticket information is available on the Montgomery and MTEA websites. The MTEA is also working diligently toward a collective bargaining agreement.

Board Member Delegate/Representative Reports

Ms. Bursh noted that the next meeting of the Municipal Alliance is on May 14th, and the PTSA will be meeting on May 17th. It was noted that the YMCA may be looking to locate in Montgomery with two sites being considered.

Board Committee Reports

Assessment, Curriculum and Instruction Committee Report

Mr. Doshi noted the following:

- The next meeting will be May 19th
- A presentation has been given to the committee by the director of pupil services on special education. An audit of special education will be conducted in the near future, with a focus on budgeting, staffing, use of paraprofessionals, and other items. The goal of the audit is to determine the best way to effectively utilize resources. The last audit was done in 2013. The planned audit will be by the same company in order to assess in the same manner the procedures and processes.
- The committee is reviewing K-8 curriculum, including the Teacher's College Reading and Writing Program
- The committee is looking to analyze how GPA is calculated and grading in general, looking at social/emotional factors in addition to academic excellence inherent in grading as it pertains to Montgomery students

Operations, Facilities and Finance Committee Report

Mr. Jacey reported that the next meeting will be Monday, May 21st. The tennis courts should be usable by mid-May. Mr. Dave Klein, Supervisor of Buildings and Grounds, is working with the tree commission on planting of trees at the schools. Mr. Cavalli reminded Mr. Jacey that the committee also needed to present a rough number on busing. Mr. Jacey responded that this was one of the topics to be discussed at Monday's meeting.

Human Resources and Negotiations Committee Report

Ms. Miller reported that the committee is discussing personnel issues.

Communication and Advocacy Committee Report

Chairs and Policy Committee Report

Mr. Cavalli stated that the committee was trying to keep policy "front and center" and asked that the board consider re-establishing a policy committee. He also mentioned that a discussion was

taking place regarding having Ms. Nastus continue on for another year. The committee is also looking for a set of metrics to determine routinely if programs are working.

President's Report

Ms. Gartenberg made the following comments:

- Noted that Ms. Karen Dudley, Assistant Principal at Orchard Hill Elementary School, had accepted a position in another district as a principal, wished her well, and spoke of the replacement that would be sought.
- Informed the board that approximately ten employees would be retiring and a celebration would be planned.
- Thanked Mr. Adam Warshafsky, Supervisor of Visual Performing Arts, and Mr. Damian Pappa, Director of Data Assessment & Accountability, for aiding in the required evaluation of employees.
- Asked for guidance for the next board meeting regarding the update on the Strategic Plan. The board agreed to email Ms. Gartenberg questions by Friday, May 11th that would be the focus of the Strategic Plan presentation on May 22nd.

A motion was made by Ms. Chenette and seconded by Ms. Miller to reinstate the policy committee.

Upon call of the roll, the motion carried with a unanimous vote recorded

Ms. Chenette recommended to the board that Ms. Bursh chair the committee. Ms. Bursh asked that Ms. Chenette co-chair with her. Both agreed.

BOARD/PUBLIC COMMENTS

Ms. Jane Hebner spoke to the board about the level of stress among students asking that they be careful in the mandating of grading policies as the goal should be teaching and learning for students rather than an emphasis on grades.

Ms. Jennifer Riddell, President of the Association of Supervisors and Principals of Montgomery Township, vocalized that Montgomery has a talented educational staff and administration that do an excellent job in teaching and reiterated Ms. Hebner’s comments that the focus should be on learning rather than grades.

Mr. Cavalli responded that the board is hoping to look at the root cause of student stress in an effort to reduce anxiety while continuing the excellence in teaching and learning. The board hopes to determine if the grading policy is contributing to stress unintentionally. Ms. Bursh concurred that the board hopes to “tweek what is already an awesome district.”

Board Resolution: 2018/2019 Salaries for MTEA Staff:

The Board further agrees that any new MTEA affiliated staff member hired after 6/30/2018 will be compensated at a salary based upon the 2017/2018 salary guide until new salary guides are established in a successor collective bargaining agreement.

Resolution Authorizing Suspension of Employee – Approve the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Schools has recommended that an employee, whose name is on record in the Superintendent's office, be placed on administrative leave with pay, pending an investigation;

WHEREAS, the Board of Education finds that it is in the best interest of the school district to accept the Superintendent's recommendation;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the employee is on administrative leave with pay, effective April 25, 2018; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the Superintendent or her designee to take whatever steps are necessary to effectuate the purposes of the resolution.

The Board Secretary and Administration are authorized to provide the employee with the required notice and to take the actions necessary to effectuate this resolution.
